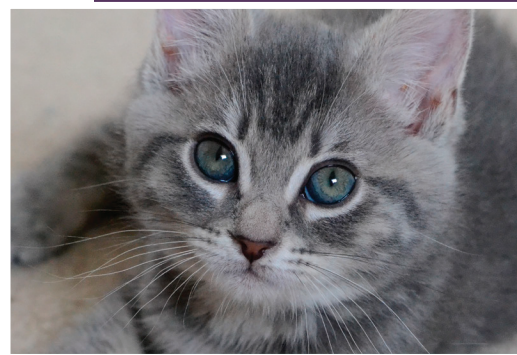
Homeless kittens can face great risks—even if they make it into an animal shelter.
